



## 'THE GARDEN OF ENGLAND' MAKE-OVER

Highways contractor, Ringway Specialist Treatments, have completed a striking makeover at the beautiful Kent village of Chilham in The Garden of England.

A popular destination for tourists, the centrepiece of the town is a square surrounded by well preserved Tudor and Jacobean shops and houses. However, the existing tarmac surfaces in the square and approach roads had seen better days.

Truegrip BN high friction epoxy resin anti-skid surfacing, manufactured by Conren Limited, was supplied delivered in bulk tankers ready for rapid installation on site.

The Truegrip BN resin was applied and finished with a special Monte Bourg aggregate and Ringway have transformed the area to provide a decorative and uniform anti-slip finish.

## MAKING WAVES IN SHEFFIELD

Conren Playon has been used to transform the Nursery outdoor play area at Hillsborough College in Sheffield. The blue & green 'wave' pattern was designed by architects Jefferson Sheard as part of an impressive new build project by Main Contractor J F Finnegan Limited. The surface will provide an attractive and safe environment for the young children to play without the risk of injuries from falls and tumbles.



The resilient Playon surfacing comprises a rubber crumb system combined with a UV stable polyurethane binder. The material is screeded into position to produce the required design and the finished Playon offers a safe surface both in wet and dry conditions.

Used at varying thickness to achieve the required critical fall height, Playon produces an imaginative impact absorbing safe play area for children. The system can also be laid at 20mm for applications such as external circulation areas, paths and walkways to reduce the risk of slips and trips.

## YORK HOUSE

Norwest Holst Building has recently completed a £3.6m contract at York House in Kensington, London. As part of the project, Conren have coated 2,370m<sup>2</sup> of car park to provide 86 parking bays beneath this prestigious luxury apartment block. Congrip heavy duty epoxy coating has been applied to the entire area in grey with a contrasting burgundy colour line marking used to denote parking bays.
